

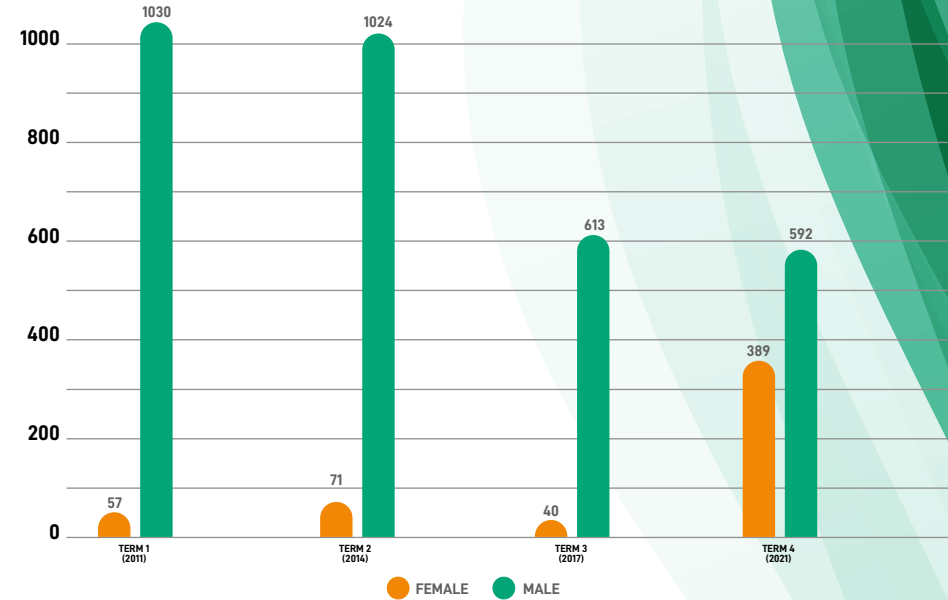
# LOCAL COUNCIL ELECTION STATISTICS

The following is information collected on the Elected councilors for the Term 1, 2, 3 & 4 of local council spanning from 2011 to 2021. Information was gathered from the Election Commission of Maldives and administrative information collected from Vuna Portal used to manage the Local Councilor information at Local Government Authority.

## GENERAL NOTES:

- Total number of seats across terms will vary due to changes to the Decentralization Act in-between terms.
- As Kulhudhuffushi Council attained city status during end of Term 3, their figures in Term 1, 2, & 3 have been included within figures for Hdh Atoll.
- As Fuvahmulak attained city status starting from Term 3, the total number of council seats in Fuvahmulak is lesser starting from term 3.
- Prior to Term 4, Council President was assigned within the elected members for the council by the member's secret vote. Council Vice President is still selected in the same manner. Since Term 4, Council President is elected directly by a public constituency vote along with members for the other seats.
- Prior to Term 4, members for all atoll council seats were elected by a public constituency vote. The Atoll Council President and Vice President were then selected among the members by the member's vote. Starting from Term 4, pursuant to changes in Decentralization Act, atoll council president is elected by a public constituency vote. Other seats of the atoll council are comprised of Island Council Presidents and City Council Mayors in the atoll.
- Pursuant to the 8th Amendment to Decentralization Act, the local council terms changed from 3 years to 5 years from the 4th Term. However, Local Councilors elected for 3rd Term remained in seat from 2017 to 2021 due to delays in 4th term elections due to Covid-19 pandemic situation.
- Since Term 4, pursuant to amendment to the act, 33% of local council seats have been reserved for women as an affirmative action.

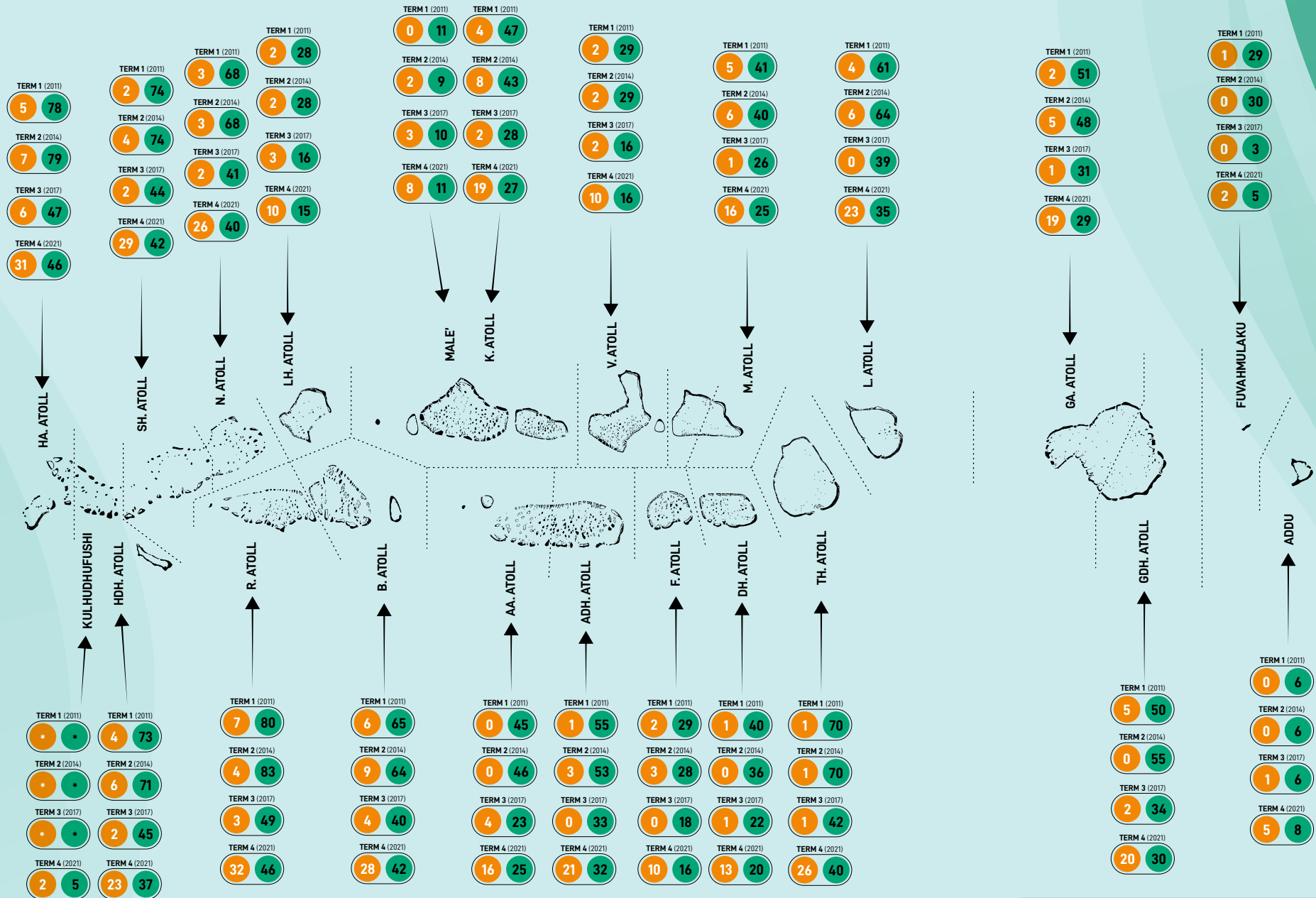

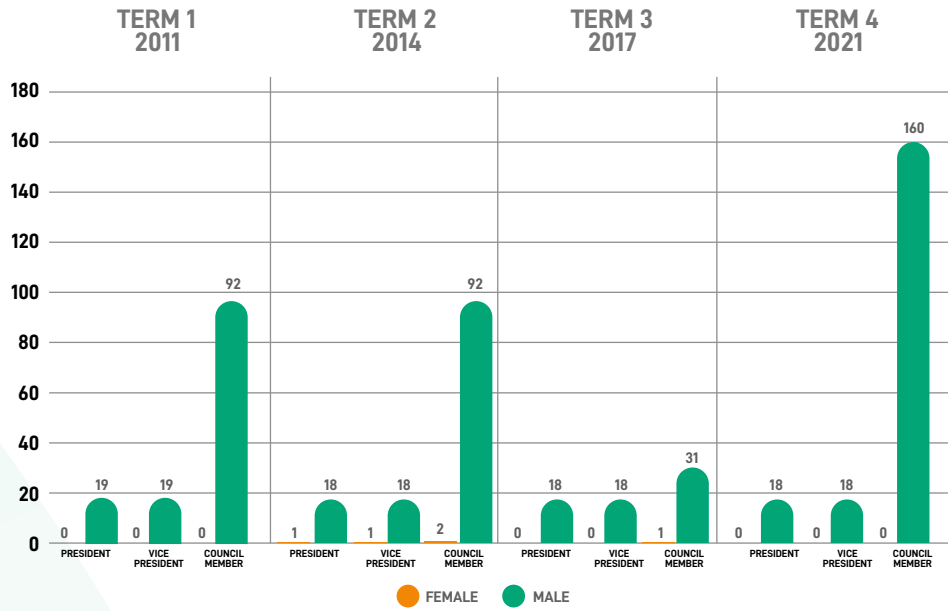

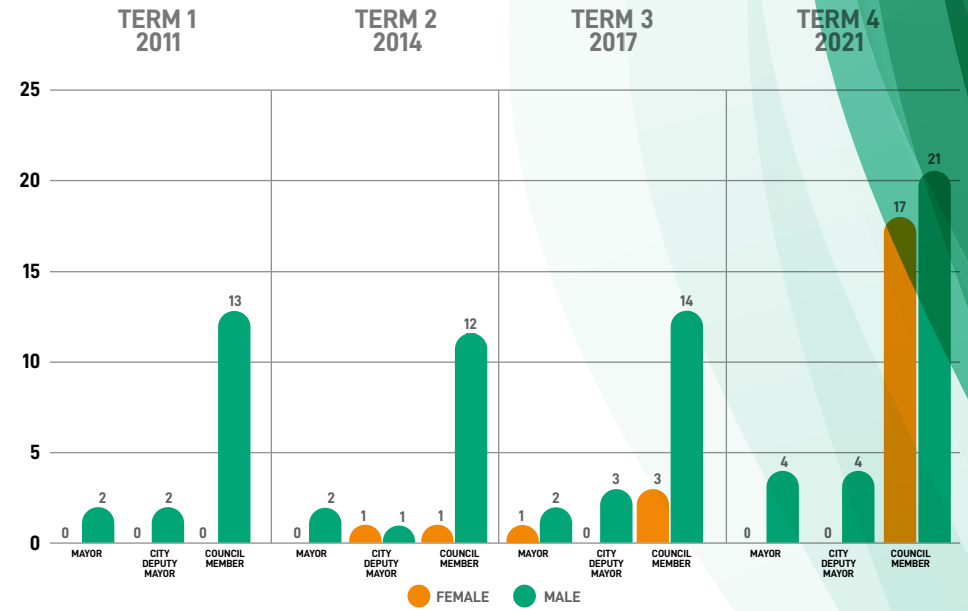

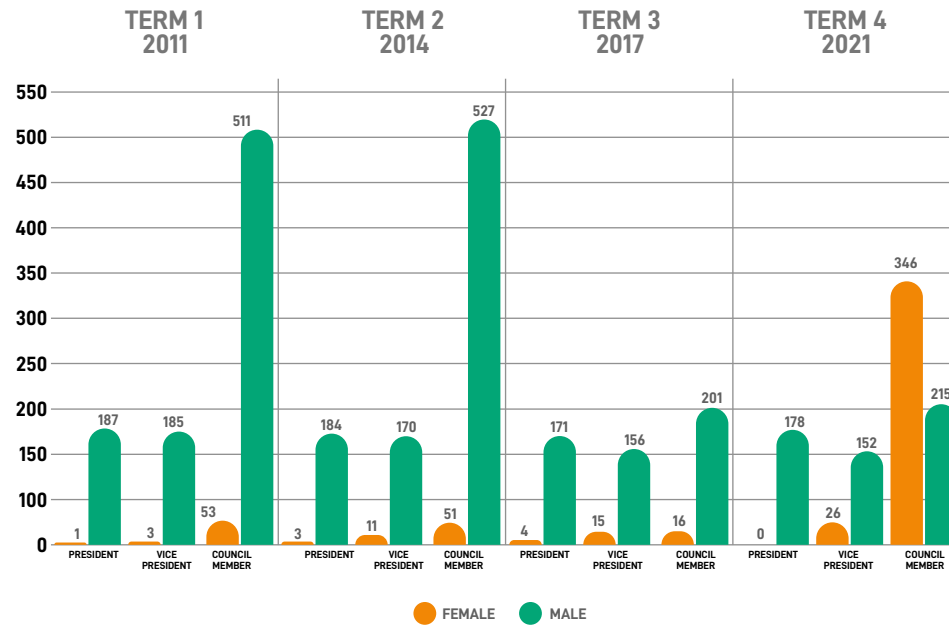

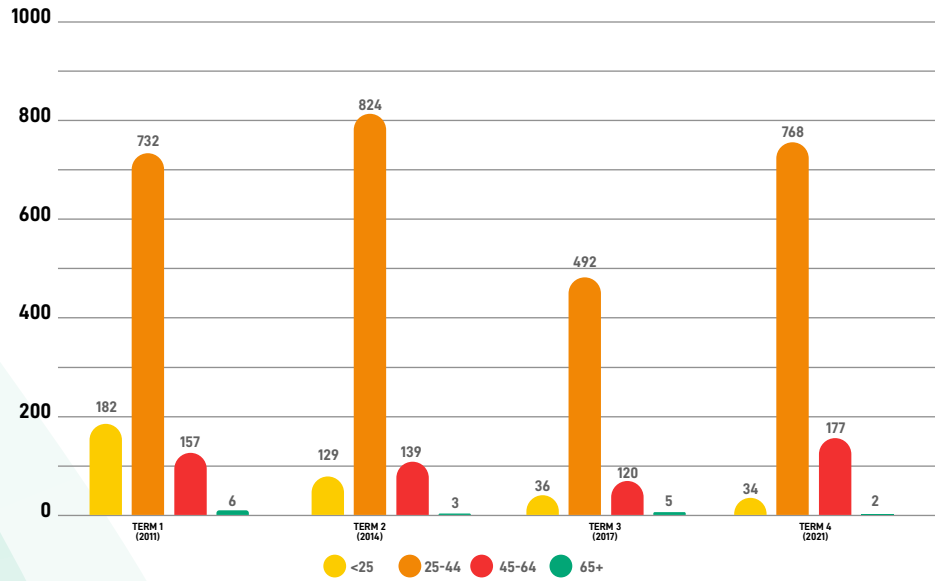

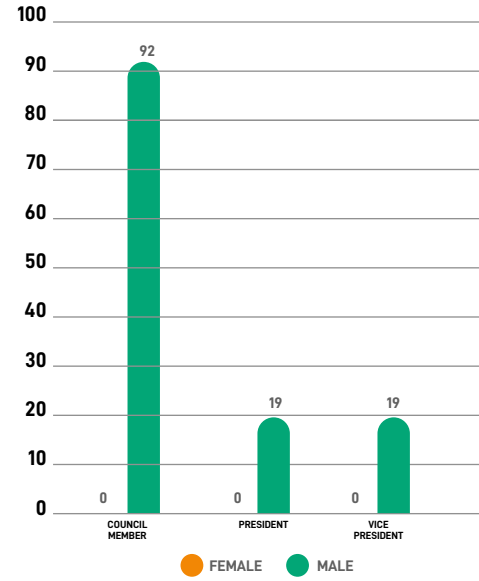

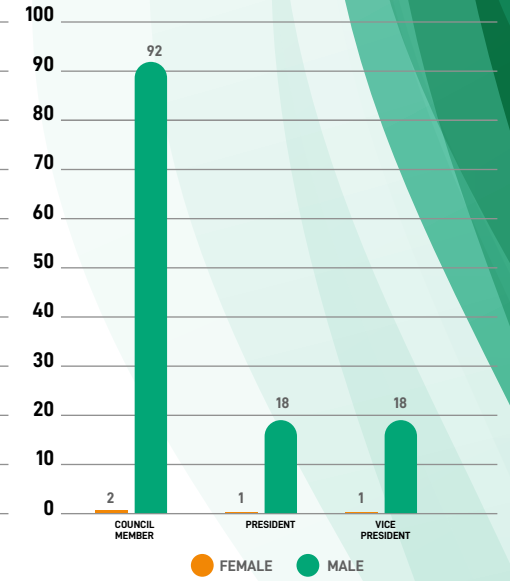

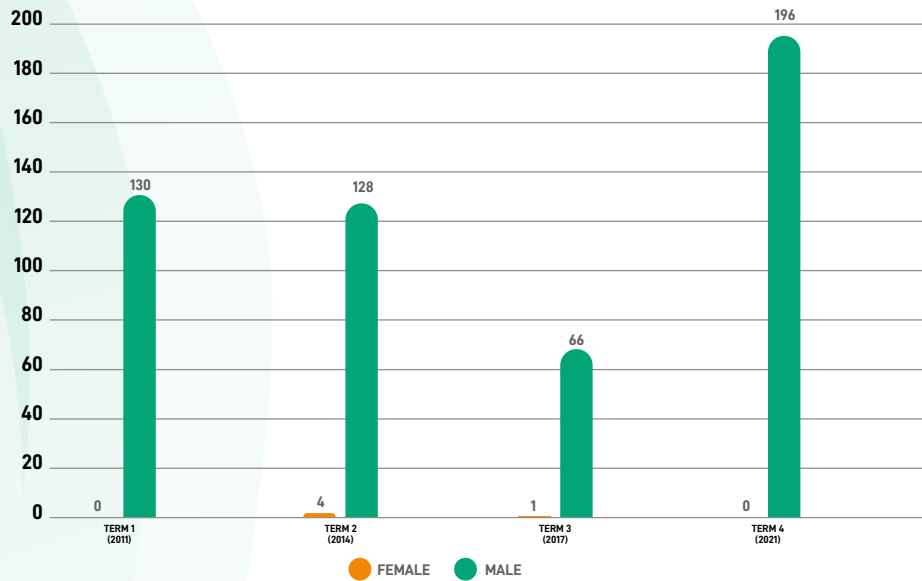
### ATOLL COUNCIL SEATS ACROSS GENDER - TERM 1 (2011)



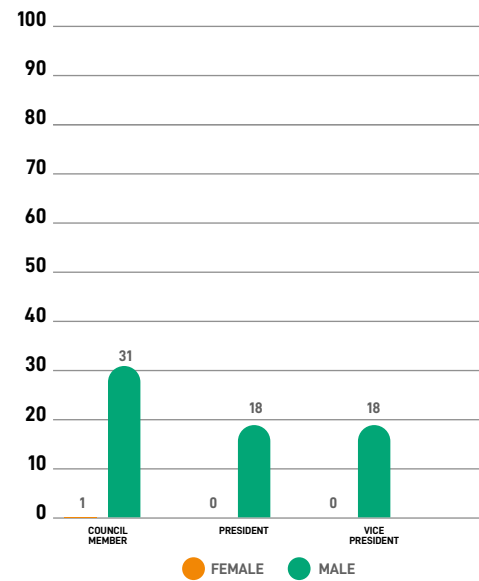

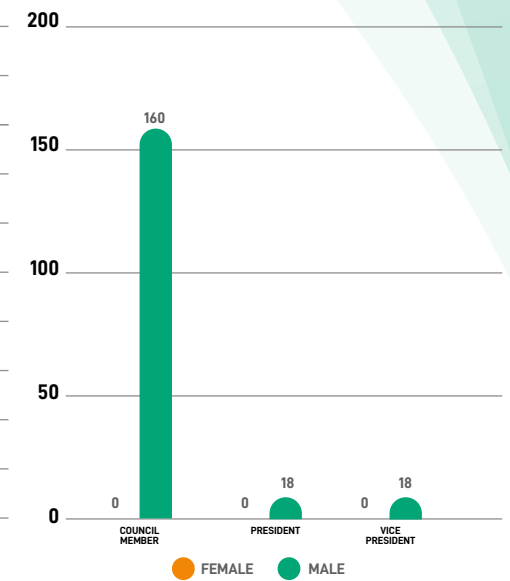

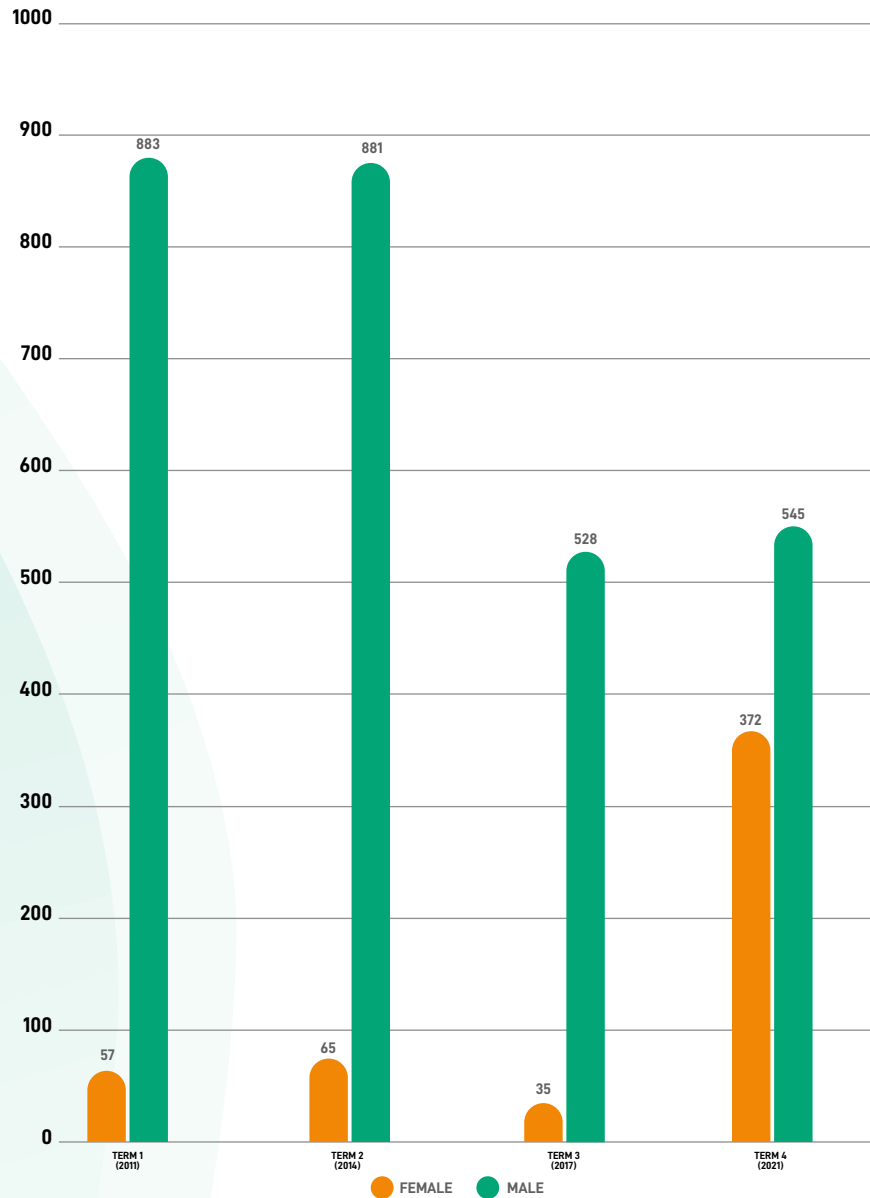

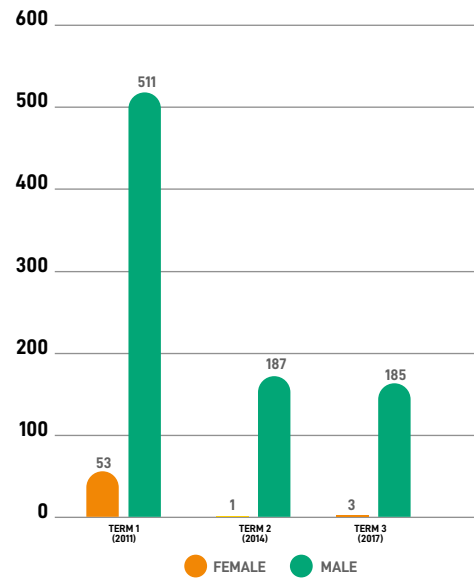

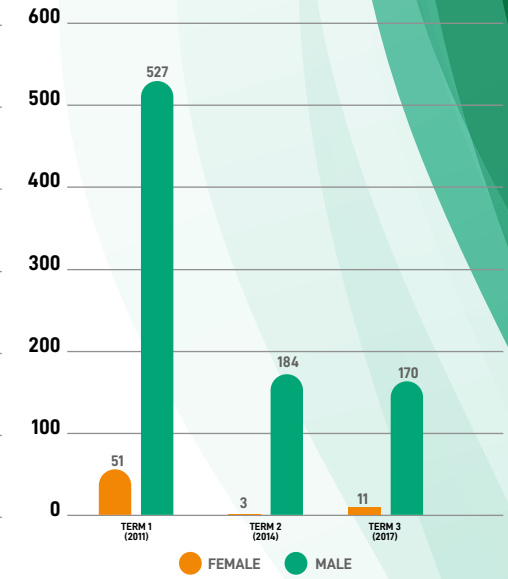
Island Council seats held across Gender



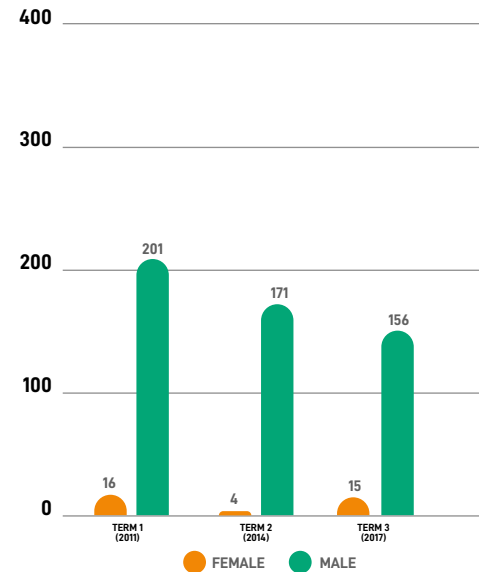
## ISLAND COUNCIL SEATS BY TYPE ACROSS GENDER - TERM 1 (2011)



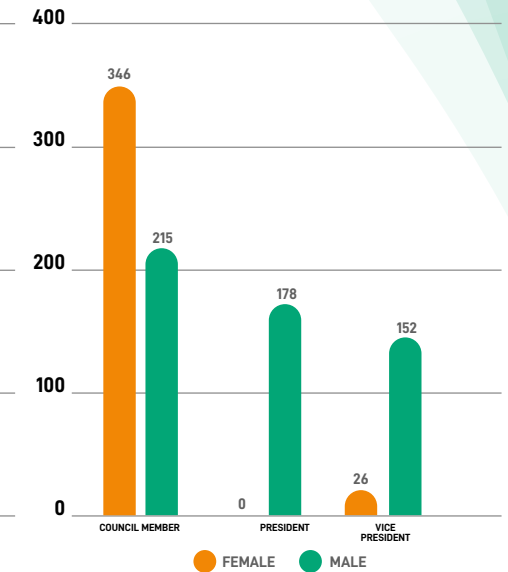
## ISLAND COUNCIL SEATS BY TYPE ACROSS GENDER - TERM 2 (2014)

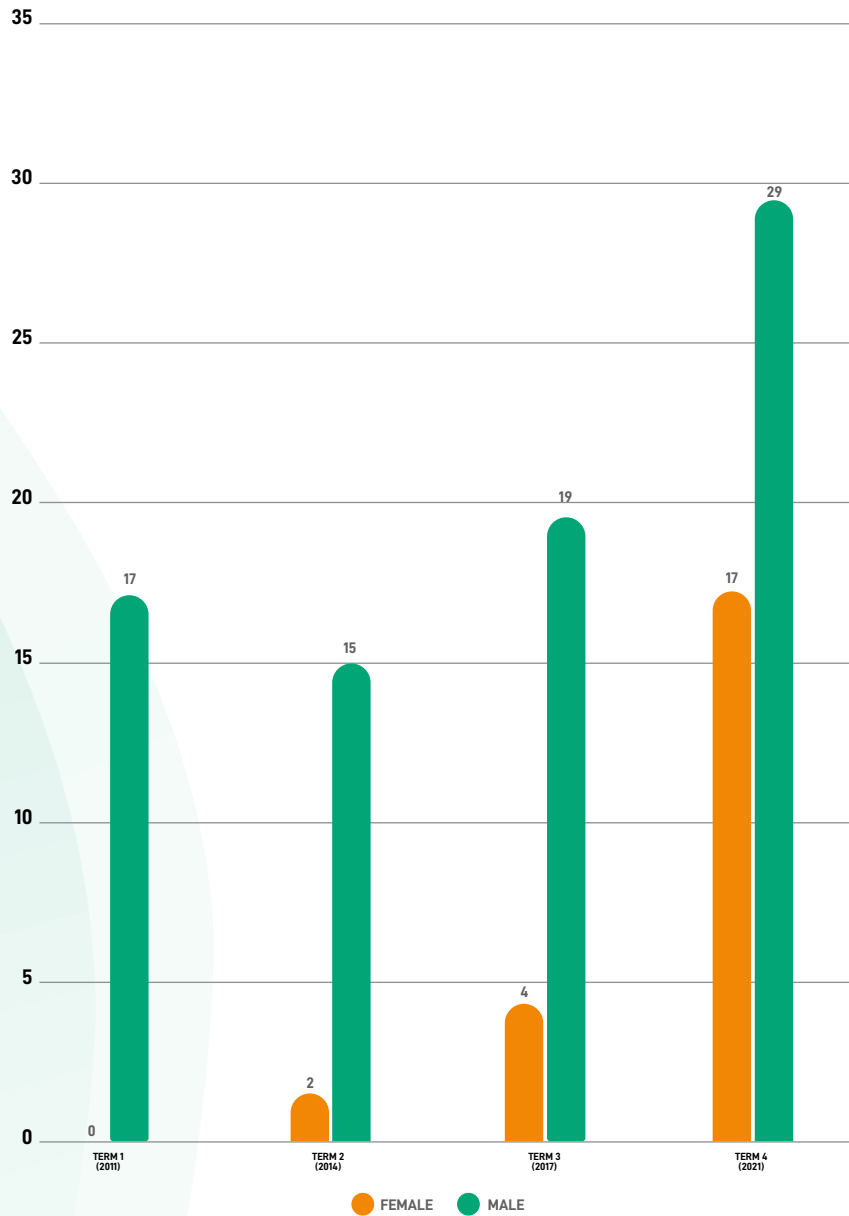

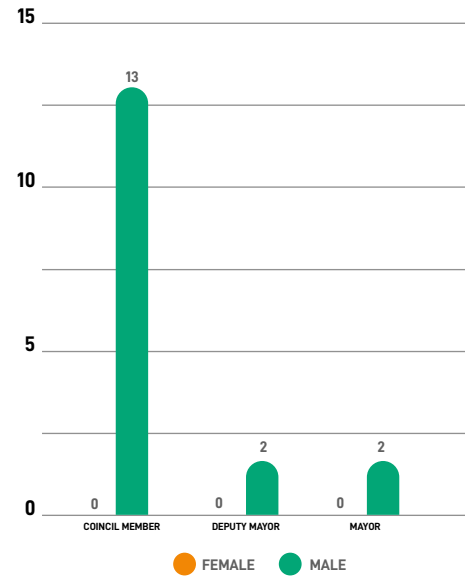

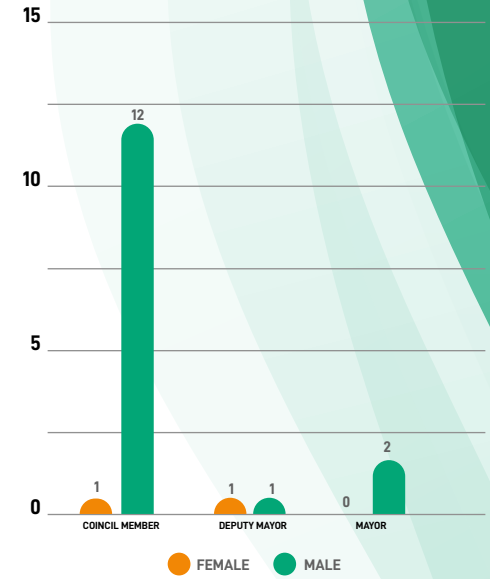

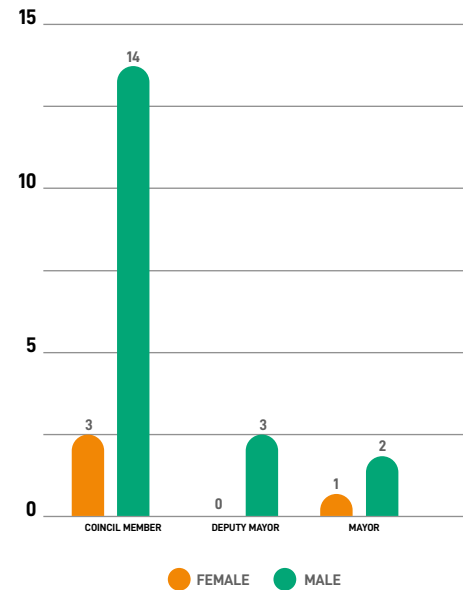
